Question/s to be Answered

I would be grateful if you could provide me with the following information and that this is treated as a freedom of information request.

- 1) How many children within the health board who are aged 5-11 are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine.

We do not know the exact number as it is made up of both children who have at risk conditions (this list was generated centrally not by the board) and children who live in households where someone is immunosuppressed. We do not know how many of them there are. Centrally generated letters have been sent to people who are immunosuppressed asking them to contact us if they have children aged 5-11 in the household and wish them to be vaccinated.

- 2) How many children within the health board who are aged 5-11 have received the COVID-19 vaccine

Approximately 50 by end January

- 3) How many individuals have received the incorrect COVID-19 vaccine dosage, broken down by a) children aged 5-11 b) 12-17 year olds and c) adults aged 18 and over, since the start of the vaccine programme.
