What is the number of breast cancer screening referrals for over 70s in each of the last five years in your health board?

Breast Screening Services in Shetland are run from the North East Scotland Breast Screening Centre which is based in Aberdeen Royal Infirmary and covers NHS Grampian, NHS Shetland and NHS Orkney. A mobile breast screening unit comes up to Shetland every three years. As a result, we do not hold this data locally and presume that NHS Shetland patients would be included in the response you get from NHS Grampian.
