I would like to request the following information.

Could you please provide:

1. The number of people with a diagnosed learning disability or diagnosis of autism or both currently admitted to a hospital or other in-patient setting within your health board area for a period of 365 days or longer
2. The number of people with a diagnosed learning disability or diagnosis of autism or both currently admitted to a hospital or other in-patient setting within your health board area for a period of five years or longer
3. The number of people with a diagnosed learning disability or diagnosis of autism or both currently admitted to a hospital or other in-patient setting within your health board area for a period of ten years or longer
4. The number of people with a diagnosed learning disability or diagnosis of autism or both currently admitted to a hospital or other in-patient setting within your health board area for a period of 20 years or longer
5. The number of people with a diagnosed learning disability or diagnosis of autism or both area currently in a hospital or other in-patient setting within your health board subject to a Compulsory Treatment Order
