### Question/s to be answered

I hope this finds you well. I am writing to make a request for information around statutory provision for equipment (such as beds, wheelchairs, mobility aids, and so on) for disabled people.

1. We understand that certain equipment is provided as statutory provision for disabled adults.
  - a. Does NHS Shetland have a core list of what equipment should statutorily be provided for disabled adults in your area? If yes, please can you share this list with us? If no, could you please share more information around how the provision of equipment is taking place, and whose responsibility this is?

There is no core list that is held. Equipment will be issued through services that individuals engage with. This will be the relevant AHP service or a combination of services.

Most aids and adaptations will be through Occupational Therapy.
